## Unwell Child

If your child will not be attending their normal session whether due to illness or another reason, please can you call, text or email the preschool as early as possible to let us know. If your child is unwell and needs paracetamol before preschool or has a temperature, we ask that they stay at home. Paracetamol tends to wear off after 4 hours and this can end up in the child going downhill rapidly.

If your child requires antibiotics, the advice we have states that they should stay off for 48 hours from the start of the course.

If your child has sickness or diarrhoea they will need to be kept off for 48 hours after the last episode. Thank you.

## Nut Free

Please can I remind you all that we are a nut free setting. Please can you ensure that there are no nut products in your child's lunches.

## Warmer Weather

We have had some lovely weather lately and we would appreciate it if a sun hat can be put into the children's bags, preferably can they please have a named hat that stays at the setting.
